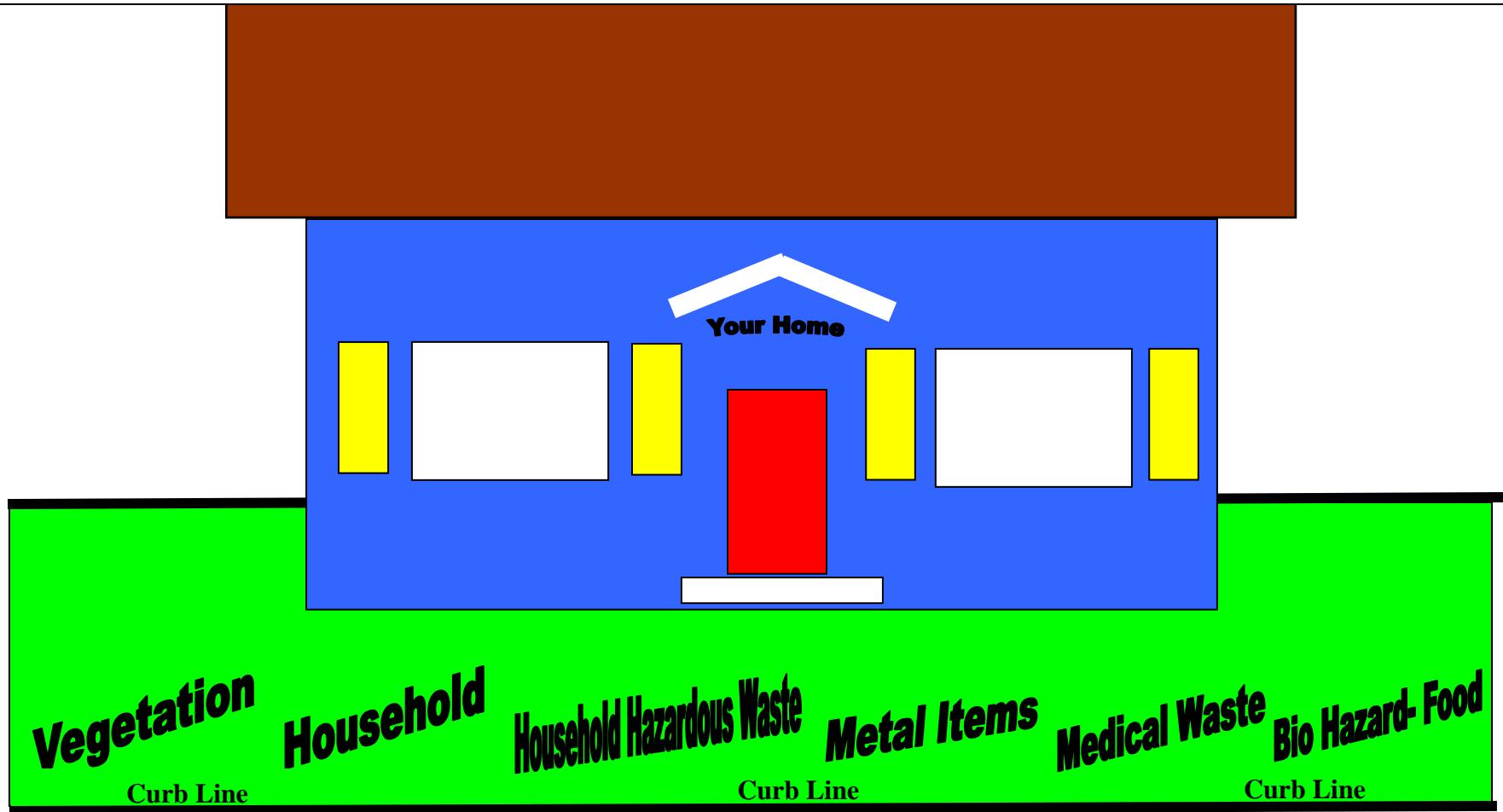


Debris Management- Once homeowners and business have been allowed back into the Borough, a massive cleanup of property will begin. Prior information from agencies that have been involved with cleanup efforts have indicated that a planned approach to the cleanup will speed up the return to a normal life style for the community. The Identified Debris should be arranged at the curb line of the homeowner's property or business property, in separate piles for ease of pickup by Oceanport DPW or private contractors who may be brought in to assist with the cleanup efforts. By separating the piles of debris, cleanup crews will be able to move quickly, focusing on their assigned task without the need to examine debris for proper selection.



Vegetation- Debris consisting of water based plants brought in from storm surge, tree limbs, tree trunks, plants, brushes.

Household- interior furniture, minor building debris, clothing

Household Hazardous Materials- Paints, thinners, gasoline, cleaning products, motor oil,

Metal Items- Washer, dryers, refrigerators, furnace, water heaters, pipes

Medical Waste- medications and sharps

Bio Hazard-Food- all food items.

Restoration- Homeowners and business owners who have obtain the necessary permits to begin restoration of their property will be required to obtain container services for all construction, demolition and miscellaneous debris being discarded from the property
