

EMERGENCY MEETING MINUTES

Oceanport, New Jersey
November 16, 2016

An Emergency Meeting of the Oceanport Mayor and Council was called to order on November 16, 2016 at 11:01 AM by Mayor Coffey.

Adequate notice of this meeting was not provided and was not reasonably foreseen at a time when adequate notice could have been provided. Notice of this meeting was subsequently provided by notice to the Asbury Park Press and The Link News on November 16, 2016, and by the posting of same on the municipal bulletin board and Borough Web Site. Pursuant with Resolution #2014-209 Establishing a Policy for the Use of Electronic Conferencing for Meeting Attendance, a quorum was established through teleconferencing upon the calling of a special meeting by the Mayor.

Mayor Coffey stated that the meeting had been called to advise the Council of matters required by law to be confidential.

EXECUTIVE SESSION:

At 11:03 AM Mayor Coffey asked for a motion authorizing the Governing Body to enter into Executive Session for the purposes of Matters Required by Law to be Confidential and Relating to Public Safety and Property concerning an active police investigation, which was made by Council President Irace, seconded by Councilwoman Kahle and approved by Council.

At 11:18 AM, Council concluded the Executive Session and the emergency meeting was reopened on a motion by Councilwoman Kahle and seconded by Councilwoman Cooper and approved by the Council.
