

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 204 (FEES) OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF OCEANPORT, COUNTY OF MONMOUTH AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Oceanport, County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey, that the following amendments be made as follows:

NOTE: Additions are underlined and deletions are marked by strike through.

Article VII. Special Events; Boat Ramp and Athletic Facilities

§204-12. Boat Ramp Fees

A. The following is established as the fee to be paid for the use of a Borough of Oceanport Boat Ramp at Blackberry Bay Park:

(1) The daily use fee for putting in and retrieving a boat:

(a) Residents: ~~\$5~~ \$10

(b) Nonresidents: ~~\$10~~ \$20

(2) A seasonal use permit allowing for unlimited use by a single boat shall be:

(a) Residents: ~~\$15~~ \$50

(b) Nonresidents: ~~\$30~~ \$100

§204-13. Athletic Facility Use Fees

Games

1. Youth Fee: (a) Resident fee - \$25 per game
(b) Non-Resident Fee - \$50 per game

2. Non-Youth Fee: (a) Resident Fee - \$35 per game
(b) Non-Resident Fee - \$70 per game

Practices:

1. Residents: \$100 per team/ (1) 2-hr practice per week for 12 weeks
2. Non-Resident: \$200 per team/ (1) 2-hr practice per week for 12 weeks

For Profit Camps: \$500.00 (no more than five days)

For Profit Tennis Lessons: \$500.00 for the period of May 1st – Sept. 30th with a maximum usage of 10 hours per week with a 2-hr per 1 court maximum per day.

Article VIII. Public Buildings

§204-14. Public Building Rental Fees

A. The following is established as the fee to be paid for use of a Borough building by a resident of Oceanport:

- (1) Blackberry Bay Pavilion: \$100.00
- (2) Old Wharf House: \$100.00
- (3) Port Au Peck Firehouse: \$100.00

B. The following is established as the fee to be paid for use of a Borough building by a non-resident of Oceanport:

- (1) Blackberry Bay Pavilion: \$200.00
- (2) Old Wharf House: \$200.00
- (3) Port Au Peck Firehouse: \$200.00

SECTION 2. All ordinances and resolutions or parts of ordinances and resolutions, inconsistent with this amending ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This amending ordinance shall become effective upon due passage and publication according to law.
