NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF BOND ORDINANCE #922 AND SUMMARY

The bond ordinance, the summary terms of which are included herein, has been finally adopted at a meeting of the Borough Council of the Borough of Oceanport, in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, held on December 4, 2013 and the 20-day period of limitation within which a suit, action or proceeding questioning the validity of such bond ordinance can be commenced, as provided in the Local Bond Law, has begun to run from the date of the first publication of this notice. Copies of the full ordinance will be available at no cost and during regular business hours, at the Borough Clerk's office for the members of the general public who shall request the same. The title and summary of the terms of such bond ordinance follows:

Title: **AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF OCEANPORT, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY, PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A BUILDING IN BLACKBERRY BAY PARK AND RELATED EXPENSES OF THE BOROUGH OF OCEANPORT AND APPROPRIATING \$700,000 THEREFOR AND PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF \$665,000 IN GENERAL IMPROVEMENT BONDS OR NOTES OF THE BOROUGH OF OCEANPORT TO FINANCE THE SAME.**

Purpose/Improvement: The construction of a building to be located in the Borough's Blackberry Bay Park, including, but not limited to, construction costs, design, inspection and furnishings, and including all work and materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto.
