

**BOROUGH OF OCEANPORT, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY**  
**NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF BOND ORDINANCE #929 AND SUMMARY**

The bond ordinance, the summary terms of which are included herein, has been finally adopted at a meeting of the Borough Council of the Borough of Oceanport, in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, held on March 20, 2014 and the 20-day period of limitation within which a suit, action or proceeding questioning the validity of such bond ordinance can be commenced, as provided in the Local Bond Law, has begun to run from the date of the first publication of this notice.
