

**BOROUGH OF OCEANPORT

**Notice of Adoption of Ordinance #951 and Summary**

The ordinance providing for a special emergency appropriation, the terms of which are summarized below, has been finally adopted by the Borough Council of the Borough of Oceanport, in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, on June 4, 2015 and the 20-day period of limitation within which a suit, action or proceeding questioning the validity of such ordinance can be commenced, as provided in the Local Bond Law, has begun to run from the date of the first publication of this notice. Copies of the full ordinance will be available at no cost and during regular business hours, at the Clerk's office for the members of the general public who shall request the same. The title and summary of the terms of such bond ordinance follows:

Title:           **AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF OCEANPORT, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY, PROVIDING FOR A TOTAL SPECIAL EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION OF \$220,000 COMPRISED OF \$185,00 FOR THE PREPARATION AND EXECUTION OF A COMPLETE PROGRAM OF REVALUATION OF REAL PROPERTY FOR THE USE OF THE LOCAL ASSESSOR AND \$35,000 FOR THE PREPARATION OF APPROVED TAX MAPS**

The purpose of this ordinance is to provide for a special emergency appropriation of \$220,000 comprised of \$185,000 for the preparation and execution of a complete program of revaluation of real property for the use of the local assessor and \$35,000 for the preparation of approved tax maps.
