It will be further considered for final passage, after public hearing thereon, at a meeting of said Mayor and Council to be held in the Maple Place School, 2 Maple Place, Oceanport, NJ on Thursday, March 15, 2018 which begins at 7 P.M. Copies of said proposed ordinance may be obtained, without cost by any member of the general public from the Office of the Municipal Clerk at the Borough Hall Offices, 315 E. Main Street, Oceanport, NJ during posted office hours any day of the week.

The purpose of this ordinance is to establish regulations for the permitting of peddlers and solicitors, setting of hours for which activities may be conducted, establishment of a “do-not-solicit” list for residents and the setting of violations and penalties.
