NOTICE OF PENDING ORDINANCE #997

**TAKE NOTICE** that an Ordinance entitled “**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 331 "STREETS & SIDEWALKS" AND CHAPTER 371 "TREES" OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF OCEANPORT, COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF RIGHT OF WAYS**” has been introduced and passed upon first reading at the regular meeting of the Oceanport Governing Body held February 21, 2019. It will be further considered for final passage, after public hearing thereon, at a meeting of said Mayor and Council to be held in the Maple Place School, 2 Maple Place, Oceanport, NJ on Thursday, March 21, 2019 which begins at 7 P.M. Copies of said proposed ordinance may be obtained, without cost by any member of the general public from the Office of the Municipal Clerk at the Borough Hall Offices, 315 E. Main Street, Oceanport, NJ on any weekday during scheduled business hours.

The purpose of this ordinance is to establish regulations for the maintenance of the Borough’s streets and right of ways, assign responsibility to the fronting property owner for said maintenance including but not limited to curbs, sidewalks, trees and other plantings; establish procedures for violations and failure to abate or remediate conditions. The ordinance further designates the appropriate officials to whom requests to perform trimming or removal of public trees in the Borough’s streets and right of ways shall be submitted for approval.
