Explanation of Appropriations for "Other Expenses"

The amounts appropriated under the title of "Other Expenses" are for operating costs other than "Salaries and Wages."

Some of the items included in "Other Expenses" are:

Material, supplies and nonbondable equipment.

Repairs and maintenance of buildings equipment, roads, etc.

Contractual services for garbage and trash removal, fire hydrant service aid to volunteer fire companies, etc.

Printing and advertising, utility services, insurance and many other a items essential to the service rendered by municipal government.

BUDGET MESSAGE

Appropriation Caps

Chapter 68, Public Laws of 1976 as amended, places limits on municipal expenditures. Commonly referred to as a 5% "Cap", it is actually calculated by a method established by the law.

The actual calculation is somewhat complex, but in general it works as follows. Starting with the figure in the 1984 Budget for Total General Appropriations, the following 1984 budget figures are subtracted: Reserve for Uncollected Taxes, Debt Service, State or Federal Aid, Cash Deficit (if any), Emergency Appropriations up to 3%, Capital Expenditures, certain energy costs, and mandated expenditures by state or federal law after Aug. 18, 1976 allowed in prior budgets. Take the resulting figure and multiply it by .05, and this gives you the basic "Cap", or the amount of appropriation increase allowed over the 1984 total General Appropriations.

In addition to the increase allowed above, other increases are allowed:

- (A) Increases funded by increased valuations from new construction or improvements.
- (B) From new or increased service fees.
- (C) Sale of municipal assets.
- (D) Expenditures mandated by state or federal law after 8-18-76.
- Payments required to be made pursuant to any contract with respect to use, services or provision of any project facility or public improvement for water-sewer solid waste, parking or any similar purpose or payments on account of debt service therefore between a municipality and any other municipality, county, school or other district, agency, authority, commission, instrumentality, public corporation, body corporate and politic or political subdivision of this state. Appropriations for the

items subtracted in the above paragraph may be set at an necessary level and are not subject to the "Cap".

- (F) Capital expenditures.
- (G) Certain energy costs in excess of 110% of 1984.
- (H) If the "Index Rate" exceeds 5% the increase to the "Index Rate" can be used by ordinance.
- (I) Amounts expended for the conduct of an election required by law to be held at a time other than the regular election.

Also, the "Cap" may be exceeded if approved by referendum.

The actual "Caps" for this municipality will be reviewed and approved by the Division of Local Government Services in the State Department of Community Affairs, but the calculation upon which this budget was prepared are as follows:
