RE: Landscaper Permit / Renewals

Dear Landscaper:

In accordance with Borough Code, Chapter 158:2(E) (Ch. 41B, Art. I, of the 1970 Code), if you are planning to perform landscaping services within the Borough of Oceanport you are required to obtain a Landscaper's Permit.

Please find enclosed an application for a Landscaper's Permit, returnable with a \$25.00 fee made payable to the Borough of Oceanport. Please be sure to list all vehicles being used in the Borough with a description, i.e., year, model, color, etc. and a license plate number. A vehicle sticker will be issued for each one listed.

Please be advised of the following:

- Application/Renewal is due by April 1st each calendar year
- Vehicle stickers shall be displayed / available for inspection from all vehicles
- Failure to obtain permit shall result in a violation and possible fines
- A complete copy of the Code is available upon request

NOTICE TO LANDSCAPERS

PERMITTED SERVICE TIMES:

Mon - Fri 8:00 am - 6:00 pm
Saturday 9:00 am - 6:00 pm

Chapter 267-1 and 267-1(E) of the Borough Code prohibits the creation of any audible noise by landscapers except during the designated hours above.

BRANCHES:

ALL BRANCHES AND TREE LIMBS must be tied and bundled. (3) Bundles can be placed at the curb each trash pickup day for that site. The trash contractor **will not** pick up **bundles** larger than (3) feet in diameter or in lengths exceeding (5) feet.

The trash contractor **shall not** be required to pick up any tree stumps nor individual tree limbs or branches which exceed (3) INCHES in diameter.

LEAVES

SPRING leaf pick up is from April 1 thru April 30 every year, anywhere in town.

All leaves must be raked to the curb free of any debris, twigs, stones, branches, etc. for pick up by our Public Works Department.

PLEASE

Do not put leaves in plastic bags.

FALL leaf pick up begins at the end of September.

Fall leaf pick up schedules will be published in the Borough Calendar sent to all Borough residences as well as posted on the Borough website.

Leaves will not be picked up at any other times of the year.

GRASS CLIPPINGS

The Borough encourages a "Cut and Leave It" approach to grass clippings. The Borough does not have a resource for disposal of grass clippings.

The Monmouth County Landfill in Tinton Falls accepts grass not mixed with any other type of material for \$3/carload or \$36.50/TON.

PLEASE DO NOT BLOW GRASS INTO ROADWAY

It is very important that grass clippings and other debris are not blown onto our roadways. This keeps debris out of our storm drains and out of our waterways.
